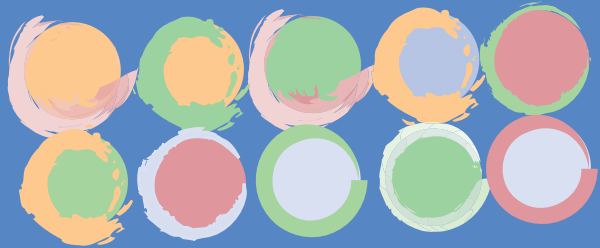

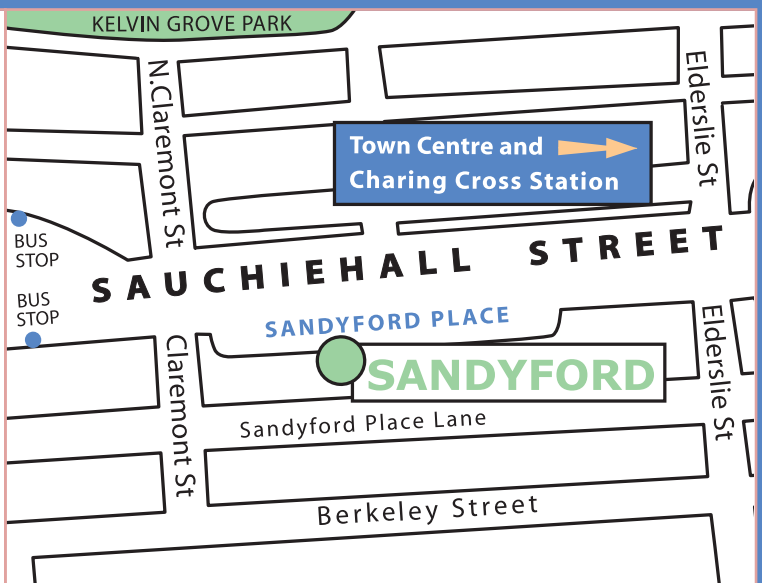

- Welcome to Sandyford Library and Information Services - a vibrant information hub offering public lending library services in an NHS setting. It's free to join, free to use and gives you access to a world of books, leaflets and information on all aspects of health and wellbeing
- Resources include pregnancy and baby care, self-esteem, relationships, menopause, eating disorders, violence and abuse, sex and sexual problems, men's health, lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender issues, healthy living and more....
- Selection of popular fiction paperbacks
- You can borrow 6 items for 4 weeks, have a browse around, or make use of the free Internet computers

Quality Health Information

- To borrow items you'll need a membership card. Either sign up in the library, register online at libcat.csghlasgow.org or use your Glasgow Community Libraries card if you have one already
- Everyone is welcome to join Sandyford Library, but to also use your card in the Glasgow Community Libraries, you must live, work, or study within Glasgow
- Any item from Sandyford and any Glasgow Community Library can be borrowed, returned or requested from any library location
- Manage your personal record online – renew books, and sign up for text or email reminders and alerts for your renewals and requests
- Explore the stock of Sandyford and all the Glasgow Community Libraries online at libcat.csghlasgow.org and reserve your chosen titles for collection at your handiest library

Freely available to all

- The library is located in the main waiting area of Sandyford – just turn left once you have entered through the main door and gone down the steps (a lift is available). You'll see the library right opposite the free Internet PCs
- The library is a friendly and welcoming place to browse and relax
- Enquiry service - just call in, or contact us by telephone or email. The staff are happy to help you find the information you need
